

# Tibberton & Cherrington Neighbourhood Watch Group

## Update for Tibberton & Cherrington Parish Council Meeting - 24<sup>th</sup> May 2018

**Nick Carter** and **Nick Greenall** took over the T&CNWG co-ordinator role from long serving co-ordinator Roger Telford during February; with Nick C in the lead role, supported by Nick G.

We recommend a vote of thanks at the Parish Council meeting for Roger Telford for all his hard work promoting our Neighbourhood Watch and making the Parish a safer place to live for many years.

**Group Database** - Nick C has received all the documentation from Roger which needs to be updated as some people's emails have changed. Work is underway to contact all those on Roger's list to ensure we have their up to date details. To minimise the impact of the General Data Protection Regulations on 25<sup>th</sup> May, we'll be asking all TCNWG members to complete new forms and will contact everyone on the lists to confirm their willingness to stay part of NW and ensure we have updated records for them. For those with out of date emails, we will be calling them first. We plan to complete this by mid-June.

**Community Messaging service (CMS)** - Nick G's registration did not go well but is now sorted thanks to helpful contacts at West Mercia police. I'm not aware of how Nick C's registration has gone so am sending him the CMS messages I get to forward on.

**Funding** - I understand £80 funding has been agreed by the Parish Council for the coming year.

**Parish Survey** - A draft has been sent to John Major and Roger Telford for their inputs as neither Nick can answer many of the questions - we simply do not have the data or experience to do so. That said, our initial view of this is that we cannot say anything glowing about police presences in the Parish, but we want to discuss this with PC Lee Thomas, ideally before the final form has to be submitted. After an email exchange, we plan to meet Lee on 5<sup>th</sup> or 7<sup>th</sup> June, with Paul Sargent and Roger present for continuity at our first meeting with Lee.

**Neighbourhood Watch Signage** - I'm going to cycle round the sign locations in mid-May to see what's what then we can do any refreshes needed.

**TCNWG Meeting** - We are looking to schedule one in late June in the Village Hall. We also plan to set up outside the shop for a few days to chat with more people and introduce them to NW to expand oput coverage across the Parish. The Shop Management Committee have agreed to us being based outside the shop as we need for this.

**Tibberton Talk Facebook Group** - Nick C is continuing to address items which come up here. Nick G does not have a FB account (and doesn't want one!).

**TCNW area on Tibberton Parish Council website** - Nick G to ask John Major if this will be possible in the Community Organisations area, so we can hold key information for residents there, e.g. CMS bulletins. That will give us a wider community reach than just emailing CMS updates to those who have "opted-in" to the Group's emailing list.
